- 3. Applicant must be a graduating senior in the current school year.
- 4. Applicant must plan on attending an accredited university, junior college or trade school the immediate fall semester after high school graduation.
- 5. Application is due by April 14th, 2024.

- All applicants must appear before the scholarship committee for a personal interview. All interviews will be scheduled JUNE 13TH, 2024 at 3:00 p.m.during the State Finals. Interview location will be posted later.
- 7. Scholarships will be awarded at the 2024 North Dakota State High Schools Finals in Bowman.
- 8. In case of a tie, it will be looked upon if applicant works both ends of the arena. Example: Boys – rough stock/time events; Girls – barrels; poles/goats; breakaway.

Scholarship funds will be received after the recipient shows proof of enrollment in the university, junior college, or trade school. The scholarship award check will be written to the recipient.
