#### Additional Information and Ground Rules

## Order of Events:

- Saturday Standard Order
- Bull Riding for Sunday will be held ½ hour after the completion of the rodeo on Saturday.
- Sunday Standard Order (except that bull riding will be held ½ hour after completion of the rodeo on Saturday)

## Open Riding

- No turning on or near barrel and pole stakes
- Be mindful of judges setting barriers and stay out of boxes while the judges are setting or working on barriers
- Saturday 9:00 am 10:00 am
- Sunday 8:00 am 9:00 am

#### **Ground Rules:**

- Rough Stock Area:
  - Stay off of chutes and refrain from moving from one side of the chutes to the other during the Barrels, Poles & Goats, unless during a rake or during a goat change.
  - o Clean up your tape and other garbage and place it in a garbage receptacle.
- Roping Events:
  - Only the contestants that are up, on deck, and in the hole are allowed into the arena. Parents and contestant helpers, please help us with keeping the arena clear by staying outside of the arena until your contestant is up and needing help.
- Barrels, Poles, Goats (boys and girls)
  - Only the contestants up on the rake or current goat are allowed in the alley/box area at a time. If you are completed with your run and the door is open, you must leave this area.
  - Parents and contestant helpers, please stay out of the alley area (this
    includes the heading box), unless you are actively helping with your
    contestant. Please do not linger after your contestant is complete with their
    run. Please find another area to video from.

# Warmup Areas

The outdoor arena and the track are available for warming up your horses.

- o In the event of inclement weather, the Western Wrangler's Board may allow additional time between events and during draws to warm your horse up. We understand it is early in the year for this rodeo. Please be patient and we will work to give the contestants their best opportunity for success.
- Weather will drive whether or not the overhead door will remain open during an event.
- Additional Holding Area: ONLY IF APPROVED BY THE WESTERN WRANGLERS
   BOARD at rodeo time.
  - If needed, Arena Director and W-W Board, may elect to use the area on the west side of the area to house additional contestants. This area is tight and will also have the pick-up men's horses.
  - Please be courteous of others.
  - o This is a holding area only, not a warmup area.
  - You will only be allowed specified times to enter this area, and will be directed to where access will be allowed.
- Please clean up around your camping areas.
- Please clean stalls. Can pile the manure and left over hay outside of the stall so a skid steer can reach and clear the area.
