The NDJHRD Qualifications (NHSRA rulebook):

- Must be under 16 years of age at the first of the National High School Rodeo Year (August 1st) and are enrolled in the 5th, 6th, 7th, or 8th grade year
- Students must be in good standing; not ruled undesirable for misconduct at school.
- They must also be eligible with their school including any tobacco, alcohol, vaping, etc.
 - violations are the right for your school to enforce and REPORT to the NDJHRD during the current school year
- Must be passing grades in at least 70% of the classes taken
