



On behalf of the board of directors, I would like to welcome you as a returning member or as a new member into the NHSRA and the North Dakota High School Rodeo Association!! This document contains **multiple forms** to be completed along with a wealth of information you need to know as we proceed into the Fall High School Rodeo season. Please take time to read the fall information guide and ground rules also found on the membership page.

Membership Information and Forms: The National Membership Application and Minors Waiver will be completed online by logging into the National Membership Portal. Visit the Membership page on the website where you will find a link for detailed instructions on how to log into the National Membership Portal along with a link to their site.

Membership Fee: You will be paying your National Membership Dues **of \$148.38** online through the portal page. This amount includes \$139 dues and \$9.38 for processing fees and covers a monthly subscription to the NHSRA Times and Western Horseman magazines along with supplemental HSR Insurance coverage for you while competing in this year's HS Rodeo season. You will need to send a separate check to the State Secretary for **\$51 to cover** your **ND Membership Dues**. Fees along with your ND Contact Information form must be sent to the association secretary three weeks prior to your first rodeo of the season.

Online Rodeo Entries: Specific procedures on how to enter our upcoming rodeos are attached to the Enter Rodeo's page (under the Rodeo Info tab) on the website. There is also a printable schedule of when each of the rodeo entries open and close.

Team Ropers: If you need a team roping partner, please contact Tammy. A list will be posted on the Membership page on the website.

Fundraising Requirements: Exact details will be shared at the upcoming fall rodeos.

Communication: The **two primary sources of communication** and distribution of information is on the <u>website</u> and <u>via email</u>. To make sure my emails don't end up in your junk or spam folders, I'd recommend adding my email address into your contact list ndhsra@outlook.com. I will be saving your email addresses from the portal page. Be sure to include as many different emails as possible within your portal page if several family members want to receive this information.

Home School Verification Form: All of those who are home schooled are required to complete the form, within this document, and upload it to your portal page.

Adopt-A-Rodeo: We continue to need your help with this program. It was created to help those rodeo committees who host a rodeo but need help on the day of the rodeo. We're asking those of you (**parents** and **contestants**) who are not associated with a specific rodeo to assist for a couple hours at one of our upcoming rodeos. It could be running a gate, setting up barrels or poles, picking up hats, chasing calves out of the arena. We all need to do our part to help these committees. **On the ND Contact form - please check the rodeos you can help at.**

Member Checklist

All your forms MUST be completed and <u>uploaded to your NHSRA portal</u> **three weeks prior** to competing in your first fall rodeo. Complete the following very carefully.

The first two documents will be found on the NHSRA website in your contestant's portal)
National HS Rodeo Membership Application Both parents/guardians MUST sign the bottom of this form along with the contestant. If a parent has sole custody or a parent is deceased that must be written on the appropriate line. You will pay your National Membership dues at this time.
National Minor's Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement Both parents/guardians MUST sign the bottom of this form along with the contestant. If a parent has sole custody or a parent is deceased that must be written on the appropriate line. This form needs to be Notarized. It is very important that the notary lists all the individuals that signed on the "appeared before me line" or Nationals will send it back to be redone.
These required North Dakota State documents are attached below.
North Dakota Waiver of Liability Both parents/guardians and the contestant MUST sign the form in 2 places. This form needs to be Notarized.
Certificate of Eligibility signed by school officials. Because your school officials are off for the summer, you can upload this form the week prior to the Mandan HS Rodeo if needed.
Home School Verification Form Those who are home schooled are required to complete this document.
Final grade transcripts from 2022-2023 school year IF you competed in the 2023 State HS Rodeo Finals, you do not need to do this step as you turned them in prior to competing at State.
Code of Conduct Read, sign and upload.
Online Entry Authorization Read, sign and upload.
Write the open and close dates for all online rodeo entries on your calendar.

The NHSRA Qualifications:

- Student must be in good standing; not ruled undesirable for misconduct at school.
- Student must be under 20 years of age at the first of the National High School Rodeo year (August 1st) and are or have been enrolled in the 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade the year just preceding the National Rodeo the contestant is entering.
- Must have <u>passing grades in at least 70% of the classes taken</u>. (For example: If you are taking 10 classes in a quarter/semester, you have to be passing 7 of them.)
- Student must also be eligible with their school concerning any tobacco, alcohol, etc., violations are the right of your school to enforce.

Code of Conduct

Any contestant or member will be disqualified from the rodeo, NHSRA Event or other function for any of the following offenses. If they are disqualified for any of these offenses, they will be disqualified from all events or other participation in the rodeo, NHSRA event or other function.

- (1) Having any association with alcoholic beverages, narcotic, tobacco products or other non-medicinal drugs while in attendance at any approved High School or Junior High Rodeo or sanctioned activity, whether at a motel or on rodeo grounds or going to or from the rodeo or at any NHSRA function. The member will be suspended from further rodeo activity for 6 weeks. If they are disqualified for any of these offenses, they will be disqualified from all events or other participation in the rodeo, NHSRA event or other function.
- (2) Rowdyism, quarreling or fighting in the actual domain of the arena at any time, or any place during the duration of the Rodeo.
- (3) Conduct or speech of any kind detrimental to the best interests of the NHSRA, NDHSRA or the sport of rodeo while in attendance, or coming to and going home from a rodeo.
- (4) Motel or property damage by contestants or their associates; damage must be reported to our Board President and/or National Director. If damage is not reported, contestant will be banned from the High School Rodeo Association permanently and reported to law authorities for prosecution.
- (5) Contestants will be disqualified for vandalism at any place or any time.
- (6) Cheating or attempting to cheat.
- (7) Any contestants or parents attempting to fix, threaten, bribe, influence, harass or coerce any rodeo official at any time.
- (8) Missing any mandatory meeting, safety seminar or equipment check.

Contestant Qualifications, pg 24, Rule #1

In accordance with the NHSRA rulebook pertaining to contestant qualifications, students who attend a homeschool, private school, religious school or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the state/province board of education or National Board of Education in the state/province the member is applying for membership. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited and that they have met the grade requirements.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the State or National Board of Education the student shall demonstrate composite grade-level academic proficiency on any State Board or National Board of Education recognized achievement test or other mechanism as provided for in State or National Board of Education rules. A student shall be eligible if they achieve a minimum composite score or survey test score within the average or higher than average range as established by the test service utilized on any nationally-normed test.
