### RULES & REGULATIONS

#### MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: BOWMAN CHAMBER

Fees go to help pay electric, garbage removal, and clean-up crews. Any other profit from camping goes towards facility improvements for future years.

#### PRICING:

Grounds Fee: \$50 to be charged per trailer/camper on the grounds. Collected at registration.

Electric Hook-Ups: \$50 Grounds Fee Plus \$35 Electricity Fee for the weekend (Wednesday thru Sunday). \$10 for each additional day. Collected at registration.

#### RULES:

1. Bowman County Fairgrounds is electricity camping only, not a full-service camping facility. Spots are limited and first-come, first-serve. No reservations accepted.
2. Spaces are not marked off to allow for more camping availability. Please be considerate when parking to allow for best access to hook-ups.
3. Must be 21 or older to rent a campsite. No minors or children camping alone. Parents are responsible for their children.
4. Anyone without a paid tag on their camper on Friday morning after contestant registration will be unplugged.
5. Camping fees are non-refundable.
6. Please be courteous to your neighbors at all times. Quiet hours are observed from 11:00 pm to 7:00 am. Keep music to a level that can be heard only on your site.
7. Profanity and excessive noise will not be tolerated at any time.
8. No littering. Please put all garbage in plastic bags and deposit the trash in receptacles.
9. Draining of gray water anywhere onto the ground is not permitted, violators will be asked to vacate the premises without a refund.
10. NO FIREWORKS OR FIREARMS ALLOWED anywhere on the premises.
11. Use of gas or charcoal grills is permitted.
12. No self-contained fire pits or campfires allowed.
13. The Bowman County Fairgrounds and Bowman Area Chamber of Commerce will not be responsible in case of fire, theft, accident or loss of any kind. It's your responsibility to carry proper insurance.
14. Speed limit is 10 MPH on rodeo grounds.
15. If Tornado sirens sound during Severe Weather, campers can take shelter in the All Seasons Arena on the Fairgrounds.
16. Only 1 camper per plug in. Overuse of plugins will blow the breakers. Violators will have additional power cords unplugged – the BCFA Campground is not responsible of any damages.
17. Absolutely no alcohol can be evident on the grounds, including all camping areas.
18. ABSOLUTELY NO horses penned at trailers and please limit the amount of time horses are tied there. We try to preserve the grass for all campers with or without horses.
19. Full service campground 1 mile down the road. For information about camping at Butte View campground in Bowman please call 701-523-3896.
20. There will be a Camp Host available for any questions.
21. We ask that you please be courteous to all volunteer help.
